Goal for Jefferson Street

To create a beautiful, lively, and memorable street that strengthens the identity of Fisherman's Wharf

Design Concept, Public Realm Plan



Primary Changes

- Reintroduce curbs to the design
- Return Jefferson and Hyde Streets to two-way traffic
- Maintain current F-line alignment
- No restrictions on private vehicles

Rationale for Changes

- Simplify the design
- Improve bicycle safety
- Calm the street
- Increase flexibility of circulation
- Minimize cost and reduce timeline

Next Steps for Jefferson Street

- 1. Refine design with input from today
- 2. Meet with tenants and property owners to confirm details
- 3. Design lighting, seating, landscaping and other site furnishings
- 4. Confirm material choices
- 5. Hold open house in 4 weeks to review design
- 6. Begin construction documents
- 7. Finalize funding plan
