Quick update. We met with the Cathedral Hill church leaders this morning. After our meeting with Michael Pappas and Rita Semel on Friday we had decided to work to move the dates of our closure. Just prior to going into the meeting with the church leaders today we received word from Caltrans that they were onboard with moving the closure back one week. We had already received cooperation from SFMTA and the Cherry Blossom Festival so we were able to deliver the church leaders the assurance that we would be moving the dates. It was a productive meeting for developing relationships and closing communication loops moving forward.

For your knowledge the new scheduled dates are as follows: Partial closures will begin Monday April 6 at 11PM to Tuesday 6AM, Tuesday at 11PM to Wednesday 6AM and end Wednesday 11PM to Thursday 6AM. The full closure will be Friday April 10 to Sunday April 12. No change to the other closures. We will be providing you with updated documents once everything is finalized.

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- We realize that the detours will be an inconvenience, but the HerreroBoldt team has worked for months with its city partners to plan for and execute the closures. Communication to neighbors has been extensive, and until late Wednesday no one had raised any concerns about working over Easter weekend.

- Alternative construction options were studied in an effort to balance the needs of nearby residents, businesses, service providers, commuters and visitors. After careful review the current approach, which includes the three full 72-hour weekend closures (two in April, one in September), was selected as the safest, least impactful and most efficient plan. Alternative options would have required between ten and twenty months of ongoing nighttime work and would have been far more disruptive to neighbors.

Per our phone conversation, below are the talking points that we have put together on the concerns with the dates of the first closure:

- The tunnel construction and Van Ness closure dates were carefully analyzed in conjunction with Caltrans and SFMTA, and all parties signed off on the selected dates because they do not interfere with any major events (street festivals, baseball games, etc.) which would precipitate abnormally high traffic volumes in the area.
- One of the reasons the weekend of April 3 was selected was because it straddles local schools' spring break and thus would likely result in lower than usual traffic on city streets. With the pending start of the baseball season, finding three-day weekends when appropriate numbers of traffic control officers are available presents a serious challenge.
- We realize that the detours will be an inconvenience, but the HerreroBoldt team has worked for months with its city partners to plan for and execute the closures. Communication to neighbors has been extensive, and until late Wednesday no one had raised any concerns about working over Easter weekend.

- Alternative construction options were studied in an effort to balance the needs of nearby residents, businesses, service providers, commuters and visitors. After careful review the current approach, which includes the three full 72-hour weekend closures (two in April, one in September), was selected as the safest, least impactful and most efficient plan. Alternative options would have required between ten and twenty months of ongoing nighttime work and would have been far more disruptive to neighbors.

- The construction of the tunnel cannot be delayed; to do so would jeopardize the overall schedule for the project. Tunnel construction was already postponed once due to the unforeseen discovery of underground utilities, and in order to finish work by Labor Day the tunnel construction must proceed as planned. This is not just about one weekend of construction, it's about a six month long construction endeavor which is critical to the hospital construction timeline.

- We are happy to sit down with nearby religious institutions to discuss their concerns and to see if there is any way to ameliorate their concerns, but we are not in a position to delay tunnel construction.

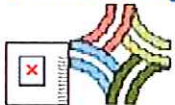
